RECOMMENDATIONS

Application to Primary Surface: Apply the adhesive side to the floor surface. Apply firm pressure. Recommended application temperature to achieve best results is 65° F (18° C) or above. Proper bonding may not occur unless adhesive and surface material are both at 65° F (18° C) or above.

NOTE:

- 1) When applying pressure sensitive adhesive films to any surface, be sure that the surface is dry, free from oil or other surface contaminates such as dirt, dust, or release agents.
- 2) Shelf life is one year from date of shipment when stored in a cool dry place below 76°F (24°C). Not recommended for in high humidity conditions or in outdoor applications.
