RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1) When applying pressure sensitive adhesive films to any surface, be sure that the surface is dry, free from oil or other surface contaminates such as dirt, dust, or release agents.
- 2) Shelf life is one year from date of shipment when stored in a cool dry place below 76°F (24°C).
- 3) Not recommended for in high humidity conditions or in outdoor applications.
